

# Commission Bill Now in House

Legislation creating a Native affairs commission was submitted in the House this week at the request of Governor Hickel. four-year terms at the pleasure of the governor and receive per diem and travel expenses, but no salary.

Announced in last week's TUNDRA TIMES, House Bill 277 will set up a commission of 25 to 60 Alaskan Natives. They will be selected to give the broadest possible representation for the various Native groups.

They will serve overlapping in the State government.
