PUBLIC NOTICE COASTAL POLICY COUNCIL

The Alaska Coastal Policy Council (CPC) will meet at the Egan Convention Center in Anchorage, on September 26, 1989, beginning at 9:00 a.m. Agenda items will include:

1. Action on the City of Whittier Coastal Management Program. A public hearing will be held.
2. Action on a petition for reconsideration submitted to the CPC by Trustees for Alaska, on behalf of the City of Kaktovik and two Kaktovik residents regarding a consistency determination for state oil and gas lease Sale 55, and implementation of the North Slope Borough Coastal Management Program.
3. Discussion of procedures for implementing the Alaska Coastal Management Act, AS 46.40.100, Compliance and Enforcement. The procedures will address the processing of petitions to the CPC regarding the implementation of approved district coastal management programs.

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT DAMAGE ASSESSMENT PLAN FOR THE EXXON VALDEZ OIL SPILL

A draft damage assessment plan for the Exxon Valdez oil spill has been jointly authored by the State of Alaska, the U.S. Departments of Agriculture and the Interior and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration acting as natural resource trustees under the provisions of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act and the Clean Water Act.
