University of Alaska Anchorage graduate psychology students will work with the Alaska Native population through two new internships in 1990, according to the University of Alaska Anchorage.

An internship at the Alaska Native Medical Center and one at Southcentral Foundation will provide UAA master of science in counseling interns, supervised by licensed clinical psychologists, with opportunities to work with and learn about the Alaska Native population.
