The primary focus of this program is to provide business services to Native and minority owned businesses. Part of these services include implementation and management of a revolving loan fund. You are eligible for the loan fund if:

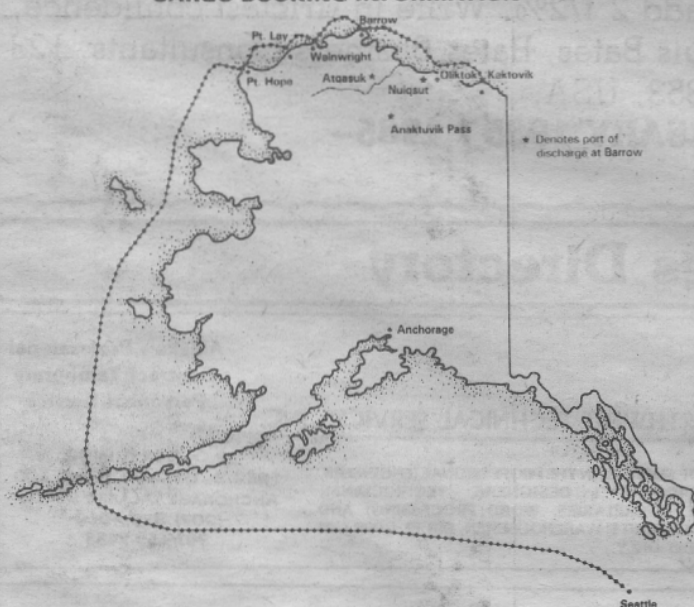
- You are a Native or other minority small business owner or village corporation located in the Fairbanks North Star Borough.
- The loan would create new jobs or secure old jobs, diversify or stabilize the economy, enhance Native managerial skills, or attract local capital.
- You have company and/or personal assets to secure the loan. Other information you should know:
- Loan amounts between \$5,000 and \$50,000.
- Interest rates 2% below New York prime.
- Maximum loan period is 5 years.

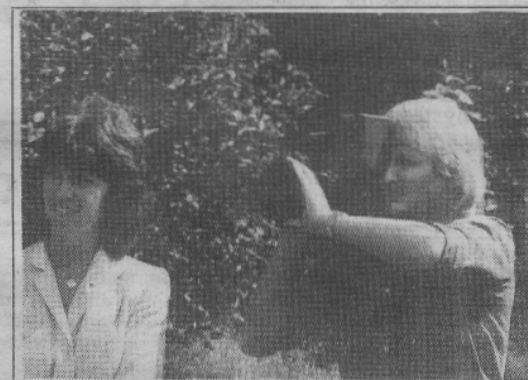
