Bay By-Lines is for Sale

After four and a half years of publishing, the Bristol Bay By-Lines has suspended operation upon the resignation of editor Dorothy Anderson.

The By-Lines, owned and operated by Bristol Bay By-Lines, Ltd., Dillingham, is a local, independently owned newspaper. The weekly paper was begun by a group of volunteers October, 1972 and grew from a mimeographed paper to a printed paper with a circulation of 1000.

At a recent board meeting the directors of the operation stated that they are interested in leasing or selling the operation noting that there is a definite need for the written word in the Bay area, and they want to see a paper continued.
