NOTICE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS

The Maintenance Section of the Department of Highways, Interior Division has applied for a permit to control roadside brush by means of herbicide application. The spray program for 1977 will be limited in scope, and is intended primarily as a means of observing and evaluating the effectiveness of several different herbicides. The herbicides being considered are amonium sulfonate produced under the brand name Ammate X, and picloram and 2, 4, D produced under the brand name Tordon.

Application will begin during the first part of July 1977, and weather permitting, will be completed on July 31, 1977. The following locations and estimated acreage have been selected for treatment this year:

Parks Highway M.P. 276.3 1 acre (RR x-ing)
Parks Highway M.P. 308.7 1 acre (RR x-ing)
Old Nenana Highway (Ester Siding) 1 acre (RR x-ing)
Anderson Road M.P. 5.1 1 acre (RR x-ing)
Sheep Creek Road M.P. 0-0.5 .5 acre West side only)
Badger Loop Road M.P. 1-1.7 3.5acres (both sides)
Richardson Highway M.P. 354-361 5 acres (Median Ditch Only)

Alaska Highway M.P. 1399-1402 (Both sides) 1418-1420 (South side only)

The liquid herbicides will be applied by means of a truck mounted hydraulic spray apparatus, primarily in areas where the brush has recently been cut mechanically. Tordon pellets will be used on a limited basis for broadcast and spot application in specific locations. Herbicides will not be applied closer than 100 feet to streams, lakes or residential units, when wind velocity exceeds 10 mph during times of precipitation or in proximity to roadside berry patches.

The entire program of herbicide application will be conducted under written permit issued by the the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.
