

d-2 Hearings Are Set For Southeast, Fairbanks, and Anchorage

Congressional hearings on the d-2 question will be held in Alaska during July and August. Persons wishing to testify at the hearings to be held July 5, 7 and 9, in Sitka, Juneau, and Ketchikan must register by June 24. Persons planning to testify during hearings in Anchorage on August 12 or Fairbanks August 20 must register by July 29.

Registration is being handled by the Subcommittee on General Oversight and Alaska Lands, House Interior and Insular Affairs Committee, Room 408, Washington D.C. 20515.

Section d-2 of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act contained provisions under which the Secretary of the Interior could withdraw up to 80 million acres for consideration as new or additions to existing National wildlife refuges, parks, forests, or wild and scenic rivers.
