

Survey Says Voters Want Gambling

A statewide voter survey conducted by Rowan Group Inc. of Washington, Anchorage and San Juan indicates that Alaska voters are inclined toward legalizing gambling in the state.

The survey of 317 registered voters scattered proportionately by voting history throughout the state showed interest in a package of gambling possibilities to legalize.
