Agronomy Specialist to be offered in Fairbanks. Responsibilities will vary, depending upon the needs of the agricultural industry in Alaska. May work with clientele in cooperation with field agents; however, major responsibility will be working with field agents in providing leadership and support in the development and implementation of agronomy programs. Special emphasis will be on small grain and forage production for sub-arctic growing conditions. Other responsibilities include (not inclusive listing) maintaining currency in research and maintaining an up-to-date data base; providing training for agriculture staff and educational materials in crop production and management; developing news packets (newspaper, radio, TV); and working cooperatively with research personnel, other departments and agencies when appropriate in interdisciplinary planning and problem-solving. Qualifications include (not inclusive listing) minimum of Master's degree required, with major emphasis in agronomy or crop science; three years' experience in specialty or closely related field; knowledge of Extension philosophy and methodology; successful experience in planning and delivering educational programs in cross-cultural settings; and ability to translate research results into practical applications via programs, consulting and written communications. 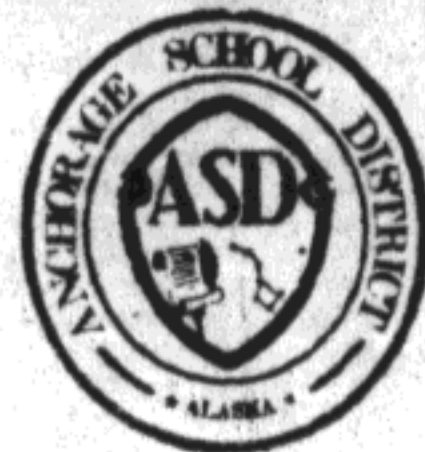
