31 Unlisted Villages Ask for Certification with BIA

Thirty-one villages not listed in the Settlement Act have filed applications for certification with the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the September I deadline, according to spokesmen for the bureau. Under Interior Department regulations, September 1 was the deadline for unlisted villages to apply for

certification.
