

OVR Counselor to Be In Barrow

Leonard Hamilton, Counselor of the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation in Fairbanks has announced that he will make a field trip to Barrow seeking referrals to the Agency.

Eligibility for services is based upon the presence of a physical or mental disability resulting in a limitation of activity. There must be a handicap to employment caused by the limitations of the disability. There must also be a reasonable expectation that OVR services will benefit the applicant.

The OVR provides not only training for new occupations, but provides vocational counseling, but provides vocational counseling, and in some cases physical restoration only.
