ENERGY RATED HOMES OF ALASKA Home Energy Rebate AND Program Changes

HOME ENERGY REBATE DEADLINE

A home owner now has one year after an "as is" rating to make improvements, get post-improvement rating and apply for a rebate under the Home Energy Rebate Program. **If a home owner received an "as is" rating before June 1, 1994, they have until October 31, 1995, to apply for the rebate.**

LIFE OF A HOME ENERGY RATING

Effective July 1, 1995, a home energy rating issued by Energy Rated Homes of Alaska is valid for **ONE** year from the date on which the home was rated or until structural changes are made to the home that affect its energy performance (whichever comes first). This change has been made because a home energy rating is a "snapshot" of the energy features a home has at the time it is inspected. A home's energy performance changes with time or structural changes.

To qualify for the various energy incentive programs offered by Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC), the supporting rating must be less than a year old and accurately reflect the present condition of the home. A rating that is more than one year old may still be used to demonstrate compliance with the Alaska Building Energy Efficiency Standard (BEES) because it documents that the home met the energy standard when it was constructed.
