

Committees to meet

The week of September 17th promises to be a busy one at the CEDC offices. Several committees of the board of directors will attend meetings and training sessions during that week.

Training for committee members will be held on Monday and Tuesday, September 17th and 18th. The training will be conducted by Richard Keyes of the National Training Institute for Community Economic Development (NTICED). NTICED is located in California and was organized to provide specialized training for the directors of Community Development Corporations like CEDC. Mr. Keyes has been to Alaska on two previous occasions to provide training to the CEDC board of directors. The training program this

time will concentrate on a review and analysis of CEDC's investment strategy as well as committee structures.

Following two days of training will be the committee meetings. Those committees which are scheduled to meet on the 19th are: Personnel and Program Policy, Budget and Finance, OEDP, and Bylaws and election. On September 20th the Grant and Loan Review and Executive Committees will meet. The committees will review the CEDC staff organizational structure, select an audit firm for the corporation, review election procedures for the upcoming annual meeting, review the corporation's bylaws for possible revisions, and review the requests for assistance received from the communi-

ties.
