Proposals for changes in hunting regulations are to be considered in March are being accepted by the Alaska Board of Game until January 19, 1980.

Regulations to be considered are listed on pp. 71-72 of the 1979 hunting regulation booklet. Proposals should address specific changes and should include an explanation of 250 words or less. Samuel J. Harbo, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Game said, "It is especially important to state the intent of the proposal clearly, so that later efforts to restate proposals in legal language are accurate and to give the Board all the information necessary to decide on each proposal." Proposal forms are available at all Department offices, and use of these forms is advised.

The public is encouraged to work with local Fish and Game biologists and Local Advisory Committees in the preparation of the proposals.
