NOTICE OF ADDENDUM Request for Proposal

During the week of November 12, 1979, the Community Employment and Traning Assistance (CETA) Division solicited proposals to conduct a feasibility study and a comparative cost analysis study to determine the need and to develop specifications for the ac quisistion of an Automated Data Processing system (ADP). This system will support the recordkeeping and reporting requirements of the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) program, administered by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
