Sealed bids in single copy for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment, and performing all work on Project AL-0414(4), Homer, East described herein, will be received until 2:00 p.m. prevailing time, July 18, 1974 in the Commissioner's Office, Department of Highways, Island Center Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project will consist of grading, drainage, and emulsified asphalt surface mixture on 9.7 miles of roadway near Homer, Alaska. Minor grading work will be performed on an equipment rental basis.

NOTICE OF FILING OF UTILITY
TARIFF REVISION

The ALASKA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION hereby gives notice that NORTHERN COMMERCIAL COMPANY (NC Co.), which operates an electric utility at McGrath, Alaska, has filed a Tariff Revision (TAI-44) consisting of its complete tariff including rules, regulations, and rates. The new filing, titled Tariff No. 2, II, supersedes and replaces its currently effective Tariff No. 1. NC Co. states that the purpose of this filing is to conform its tariff to the requirements of the Commission's Tariff Rules.

The proposed rules and regulations cover authority for tariff; nature of services offered; types of service; technical provisions; service conditions; extension of facilities; service connections; billing and collection; special services; liability of company; complaints; definitions; and standard forms.

According to the utility the rates, fees and charges contained in Tariff No. 2 are the same as those which have been in effect since May 15, 1967, except for charges relating to reconnects and service calls. The charge for reconnection during regular working hours has been increased from \$10.00 to \$15.00; after working hours the charge remains the same at \$25.00. A service call during working hours resulting from service interruption due to customer's equipment will be billed at \$15.00 per call; the charge for a service call after working hours will remain at \$25.00.

More detailed information may be obtained from the utility whose address is 1110 Third Avenue, Seattle, Washington 98101. The complete filing is available for inspection also at the offices of the Alaska Public Utilities Commission, 1100 MacKay Building, 338 Denali Street, Anchorage, Alaska 99501.

Any interested party may file with the Commission by 4:30 P.M., a statement of his views and specific reasons in favor of, or in opposition to, the tariff revision proposed by the utility, together with written confirmation that the same statement has also been mailed or delivered to the utility.

This project will consist of grading and drainage on 5.6 miles of roadway, construction of 2-prestressed concrete girder bridges, construction of 400 feet of temporary timber trestle, asphalt surface treatment on 2.3 miles and crushed base surfacing on 3.3 miles. All work located at Fairbanks, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist of the following: 14 acres of clearing and grubbing and 30 acres of hand clearing; 37,000 cubic yards of unclassified excavation; 700,000 tons of selected material; 26,000 tons of crushed base material (includes 20,000 tons for stockpiling only); 18,000 tons of subbase A; 24,000 tons of subbase C; 10,000 tons of subbase E for stockpiling only; 1,400 tons of cover coat aggregate for surface treatment; 1,600 linear feet of 24" pipe conduit and 1,000 feet of 18" pipe conduit; 950 linear feet of beam type guard rail; 228 square feet of standard signs; 400,000 square feet of seeding; approximately 232 cubic yards of Class "A" concrete and 29,000 pounds of reinforcing steel, lump sum all required; 14 prestressed concrete girders 85'-2" long and 14 prestressed concrete girders 65'-0" long; 5,440 linear feet of treated timber piles; 2,238 linear feet of cast-in-place concrete piles; 185,000 board feet of untreated timber; 1,560 linear feet of metal bridge railing; 4,500 cubic yards of riprap, Class 1A; and miscellaneous items of work.
