Arnold Joins Native Foundation

Former educational broadcasting administrator Bob Arnold has joined the Alaska Native Foundation to direct development of a secondary school course on the land claims settlement.

Arnold, a former school board member, has also been a teacher and researcher-writer. He was co-author of the 1969 publication "Time for Change in the Education of Alaska Natives" and a member of the Governor's Commission on Cross-cultural Education.

Foundation President Emil Noti said the course Amold is to produce will be a collaborative effort that includes staff members at the Foundation and others familiar with the terms of the settlement.

Completion of the textbook and related materials is expected by early 1975.
