Painting Exhibition

The second National Small Painting Exhibition sponsored by Gallery North will be held Nov. 1-30 in Mount Clemens. Mich.

Minimum awards of \$1,000 cash wills be available for prizes in the juried exhibition. To increase the artists' exposure the Gallery will make attempts to have the show travel to Museums, art centers and galleries throughout the country.

The size of the paintings should not exceed 10 inches by 10 inches with a maximum size of 14 inches in either direction including the frame. Texture should not exceed 1/4 inches off the work plane. Work must be framed and ready to hang.

Paintings generally known as miniatures are also included. Prints and drawings are not acceptable. All entries must be original. Copies or multiples are not acceptable.

To be eligible an artist must be an American, 18 years of age or older and living in any one of the United States or its territories

A non-returnable entry fee, \$5 per entry or \$8 for two entries will be charged. There is a limit of two entries per artist.

Gallery North will encourage

sales of work and will charge a 30 per cent commission on all sales. The Gallery also requests the right to purchase any work marked for sale and submitted for exhibition even if it is not accepted by the juror.

Juror is Kenneth Saltmarche of Windsor, Ontario who is listed in Who's Who in American Art. Saltmarche is also director of the Art Gallery of Windsor, a painter and art critic for the Windsor Star.
