

Artist Fred Machetanz Exhibits

FAIRBANKS — Sixteen paintings by Fred Machetanz, one of Alaska's best-known artists, are now on display in the University of Alaska's Wood Center Pub, and the public is invited to view them.

The exhibit will continue through June 28. Exhibit hours are 11:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 1:30 to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

Some 150 persons attended a

reception for Machetanz in the Pub last Sunday marking the opening of the exhibit. In addition to the canvases, on loan from their owners, the exhibit includes sketches, diagrams and painting panels which show the techniques employed by Machetanz in his painting.

The artist, whom the university has honored with the rank of Distinguished Associate in Art, is teaching portrait painting on the Fairbanks campus in the current summer session, which runs through June 28.
