under the remote parcel program beginning
in mid-November.

mation about what is expected to occur in the area.

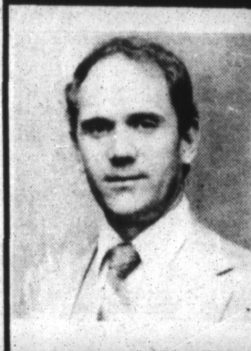
