

Home-site Entry Permit. The applicant is required to pay only survey and platting costs of the parcel. Approximately 50% of the lands available for homesites as listed above will be awarded by lottery under the provisions of AS 38.04, 020(g)(2)(c) and will not be based on length of residency. All other requirements of the Home-site Entry Program (AS 38.08), as stated above, will remain the same. Successful applicants of a home-site are still eligible for a parcel under the general Land Disposal Program.

AN APPLICANT MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN A HOMESITE AWARDED BY LOTTERY. (See the exceptions listed in the sale brochure).

GENERAL PROVISIONS.
