

Fairbanks hospital expansion hearing set

Fairbanks Memorial Hospital has submitted an application for a Certificate of Need to allow construction of a five-story addition next to the existing facility.

The addition would include: basement for data processing and storage; first floor for expansion of administration and ancillary services; second

floor to contain 40 acute-care beds; third and fourth floors shelled-in for future expansion; and fifth floor for mechanical and electrical equipment.

The projected total construction cost is \$20,000,087.

The Northern Alaska Health Resources Association, which has the legal responsibility to

review Certificate of Need applications and to obtain public comment, will hold a public hearing on the application:
