

Fink says city needs state money

Mayor-elect Tom Fink briefly went over some of his ideas that may help Anchorage's declining economy last Monday at the Anchorage Chamber of Commerce luncheon. Fink generally said it is going to be necessary to use the retained earnings of the Permanent Fund.
