NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Notice is given that the State Board of Education, under authority vested by AS 14.07.090, proposes to repeal, adopt and amend regulations in Title 4 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with high school graduation requirements, school district tuition payments, library assistance grants, library construction grants and organization procedures and functions of the State Board of Education, to implement and interpret AS 14.07.090, AS

14.07.125, AS 14.07.160, AS 14.07.020(1), (2) and (4), AS 14.07.020(10), AS 14.14.110, AS 14.56.230, and AS 14.56.230, and AS 14.56.360(a), as follows:

- 1) 4 AAC 3 is amended by adopting, repealing and amending sections to clarify and expand the organization, duties, meeting order and schedule, procedure, and membership of the state Board of Education;
- 2) 4 AAC 08.075 is amended by repealing the transition sections of the high school graduation requirements;
- 3) 4 AAC 08 is amended by repealing and adopting sections to make more clear school district tuition rates and payments; and
- 4) 4 AAC 57 is amended by adding, adopting and repealing sections to establish requirements, limits, criteria and procedures for application and applicants for grants for library assistance and library construction.

Notice is also given that comments may be made in writing to the Commissioner's Office, 801 West 10 Street, P.O. Box F, Juneau, Alaska, 99811, before 4:30 p.m. on December 23, 1987.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

The State Board of Education, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested person, may thereafter adopt these or other proposals dealing with the same subject matter without further notice or may decide to take no action on them.

REGARDING DISPOSAL OF AN INTEREST IN MUNICIPAL TRUST LAND
IN KOTZHANOK, ALASKA
BY THE MUNICIPAL LANDS TRUSTEE

On September 23, 1987, the Kotzhanok Village Council adopted a resolution requesting the Commissioner of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, acting as trustee for the future municipality of Kotzhanok, Alaska, in accordance with AS 44.47.150(b), to include the following described parcel of land in the existing lease to the Kotzhanok Improvement Corporation for the community landmark and association specific field:

The surface estate of that certain real property located in unsurveyed Township 6 South, Range 20 West, Seaward Meridian, Alaska, being situated at the Native Village of Kotzhanok, Alaska, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 9, Block 2 of the New Kotzhanok Subdivision filed as plat no. 82-12 in the Barrow

Recording District on October 11, 1982, the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING and corner no. 1 hereof; thence the following courses:

- S85°03'18"E, 290 feet to a north-south line and distance along the east boundary of Lot 9, Block 2 of said subdivision to the Southeast corner of Lot 8, Block 2 of said subdivision and corner no. 2 hereof;
- S85°03'18"E, 100 feet to corner no. 3 hereof;
- N 04°56'41"E, 290 feet to a point on the south boundary of a Grant of Right of Way recorded at Book 10 Pages 828-831 in the Barrow Recording District on April 8, 1983, said point lying 50 feet southerly of the centerline of an existing road and corner no. 4 hereof;
- N89°03'18"W, 100 feet along the south boundary of said Grant of Right of Way to the northeast corner of Lot 9, Block 2 of the New Kotzhanok Subdivision, corner no. 1 hereof, the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing 0.66 acres more or less.

Lot 9 of Block 2 of the New Kotzhanok Subdivision filed as plat no. 82-12 on October 11, 1982 in the Barrow recording District. Containing 43,500 square feet, 1.0 acre.

Aggregating 1.66 acres.

In accordance with 18 AAC 90.430 and 440 the Municipal Land Trust Officer, acting on behalf of the Commissioner of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, approves the disposal of a leasehold interest in the parcel described above to the Kotzhanok Improvement Corporation for the advanced purpose by the Department of Community and Regional Affairs. All other terms of the lease will be unchanged.
