The Library, which is a project of the Native American Rights Fund, is a national repository for Indian legal materials and resources.

Its holdings include case files on modern Indian cases and ongoing litigation, law review articles, monographs, studies, legal opinions and memoranda, governmental documents and other materials on Indian law.

Each "Catalogue" contains over 700 pages and sells for \$20.00, which includes supplements. The cost is waived for single copies to tribes, Indianowned or controlled organizations and Indian legal service organizations.
