

New film features war years in state

"Alaska at War," a new film sponsored by the Alaska Historical Commission, will have two public showings in the auditorium of the Anchorage Museum of History and Art Sunday at 1:30 and 3:30 p.m.

The film is the dramatic story of the events which shaped Alaska's future during World War II. It includes interviews with key military figures of the period and archival footage of the war.

Through the words of the participants on the scene, the film details the war in the Aleutians, the forced evacuation of the Natives from the islands, the massive military construction program and the Lend-Lease transfer of aircraft to the Russians at Ladd Field near Fairbanks.
