

HEW Opens Office of Child Development

The U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare's Office of Child Development, recently opened a field office in Anchorage. The office is headed by George Irvin, Community Representative for HEW/OCD.

Irvin will be responsible for providing technical assistance and field support to the three Alaska Head Start grantees—Rural Alaska Community Action Program, Greater Anchorage Area Community Action Agency and the Fairbanks Head Start Association.
