

Kleinfeld appointed for project

Dr. Judy Kleinfeld of the Institute for Social and Economic Research has been engaged by the Center for Equality of Opportunity in Schooling to review educational strategies for reducing isolation in small schools and to develop an instrument to assist school boards in considering such options.

CEOS director Bob Arnold said the project was launched earlier this month and will be completed by June 30, 1977.

Some of the strategies that are being reviewed are travel-study, student exchange, traveling teachers, work-study, school-community service, and use of technology. Arnold said the project was stimulated, in part by the Alaska Rural Secondary Schools Forum held in September.

Dr. Kleinfeld is the author, among other works, of *A Long Way from Home*, and *Effective Teachers of Indian and Eskimo High School Students*.
