REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Department of Environmental Conservation announces the opening of the application period for Community Solid Waste Management Planning Grants and invites the submission of grant proposal applications. The application period will close on November 30, 1990, at 4:30 p.m.

Grants for a maximum of \$50,000 per project may be used to create new community solid waste management plans, to upgrade current solid waste management plans, or to develop solid waste source reduction and recycling plans. Grants must be matched dollar-for-dollar, with cash or in-kind services. Applicants may request that the Commissioner waive the matching requirement.

The following organizations are eligible to receive these grants: a municipality, an unincorporated community, an organization representing two or more municipalities or unincorporated communities within a region, a non-profit organization, a coastal resource service area, or a regional health corporation.
