

BLM advisory group meets in Fairbanks

A utility corridor, easement management and permits for group recreational use of public lands will be discussed at the general meeting of the Northern Alaska Advisory Council in Fairbanks April 1.

The council is multi-discipline citizen's group from Northern and Interior Alaska that provides advice and counsel for the Bureau of Land Management for the management and use of federal public lands.
