The statute passed by the legislature in 1986 allowing an ELECTION BY MAIL did not go into effect until January 1, 1987. Therefore, the November 24, 1986 RUN-OFF Election conducted by mail has been voided and a new RUN-OFF Election has been ordered. Under AS 15.20.800 now in effect, the new election to be held on April 28th, 1987, will be conducted by mail.

THERE WILL BE NO POLLING PLACE FOR REGULAR IN PERSON VOTING ON ELECTION DAY

 WHO IS ELEGIBLE TO VOTE? Any registered voter who resides in the Kuspuk School District. To REGISTER CONTACT THE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS OR YOUR LOCAL REGISTRAR.

LAST DAY TO REGISTER: MARCH 29, 1987

HOW DOES A VOTER GET A BALLOT? The Division of Elections
will mail a ballot to each eligible voter at thier mailing address listed
on thier registration record.

BALLOTS WILL BE MAILED THE WEEK OF APRIL 1, 1987.

If you will be away from home during this election, contact the Division of Elections to let us know where you would like your ballot to be sent.

- HOW DO I VOTE MY BALLOT? Complete instructions and a postage paid return envelope will be sent with your ballot. The instructions will remind you to:
  - MARK YOUR CANDIDATE CHOISE ON YOUR BALLOT
  - COMPLETE AND SIGN THE BALLOT ENVELOPE
  - HAVE YOUR SIGNATURE WITNESSED
  - MAIL IT BACK TO THE ELECTION SUPERVISOR ON TIME
- 4. WHEN WILL I HAVE TO MAIL MY VOTED BALLOT BACK? You may vote and return your ballot at any time after you receive it, BUT NO LATER THAN APRIL 28, 1987. If your ballot is postmarked by the post office, it must be postmarked not later than April 28.
- 5. WHAT IF I DON'T GET A BALLOT, I MISPLACE IT. OR NEED ASSISTANCE? Election Officials will be available in each precinct beginning April 13 through April 28, if you need assistance in voting your ballot or completing your return envelope. The Election Official will also have ballots on hand if you need to vote ABSENTEE IN PERSON.
