

OEO Approves Grass Roots Fund

Two Office of Economic Opportunity grants were approved last week to the Alaska State Community Action Program including \$24,727 for adult education program in three areas and \$171,108 for Operation Grass Roots.

The three-area grant includes funds for educational services at Noorvik, classes in weaving baleen baskets at Point Hope, and English and arithmetic classes at Hooper Bay.
