Robert W. Walp, director of the Governor's Office of Telecommunications, has appointed George Shaginaw as Deputy Director.

In his new position, Shaginaw will assist in supervising the installation of the newly authorized earth stations as well as in all policy planning of future state communications services.

He replaces Hilary Hilscher who resigned the deputy position to accept employment on the trans-Alaska pipeline. Shaginaw's appointment was effective last month.

Shaginaw, 34, has been actively involved in the Office of Telecommunications earth station program planning and negotiations with RCA since the first of the year.

Since September 1973, he served as the Installation and Maintenance Supervisor of the ATS-6 satellite experiment within the Office of Telecommunications. He has also held the Chief Engineering positions at KINY-TV in Juneau, and KTVF-TV/KFRB Radio in Fairbanks.

Shaginaw has been an Alaskan resident since 1962. He is married, has five children, and resides in Juneau with his family.

Near New Office Bldg.— Bradner Wants Park

House Speaker Mike Bradner recently said he would support efforts to develop a park on land adjacent to the new state office building.

The land in question is between 7th and 8th avenues along Cushman Street, immediately next to the new state facility. Bradner said the state has added a great deal of cement to downtown Fairbanks, and that a little "greenery" would seem a worthwhile addition.

Bradner urged local groups to continue with their support and plans of such a project, and to present those ideas to the Fairbanks legislative delegation.

He added that he would like to see civic groups participate in the park as a community effort, but indicated that the state could provide any basic funding needed, while civic groups might add the "extras" to the park development.

The Fairbanks lawmaker said he also intended to suggest to the local delegation the support of additional public parking for state facilities on the Barnette Street side of the state structures.
