

THREE-DAY FISHERIES MEETING SCHEDULED

To Be at Gold Rush Hotel in Anchorage December 16-18

The Technical Assistance Division at AFN, Inc. has scheduled a three-day fisheries meeting to be held Dec. 16-18, 1975 beginning at 8:30 a.m. at the Gold Rush Hotel, 598 W. Northern Lights Blvd., Anchorage, Alaska.

The purpose of the meeting will be to establish a statewide Native Fisheries Organization to strengthen Native control of the industry. Some major topics to be covered at the meeting are:

1. A Native-controlled marketing association for all seafood products
2. Better prices for fishermen
3. Market stabilization
4. Volume intent
5. Location and types of plants
6. Utilization of existing plants
7. Construction of new plants and pick-up stations
8. Utilization and development of fishing areas

9. Processing techniques
10. Working out problems with the limited entry program
11. Development of a position on the 200-mile limit
12. Assistance to fishermen in financing gear and vessels
13. Training—management, processing, maintenance, accounting and marketing.
