

Tribal definition meeting changed

Senators Ted Stevens and Mike Gravel have announced that the schedule for the town meetings in various Alaskan communities next month has been changed. Due to the lengthening of the first session of Congress, the meetings have had to be readjusted.

The meetings are being conducted by members of the two Senators staff, and by members of the Senate Select Committee on Indian Affairs. The purpose of the meetings is to hear comments from Alaskan Natives on S.2046 and S.1920, legislation which would allow for the consolidation and maintenance of tribal governing bodies.

The new schedule includes: November 2--Ketchikan, 11 a.m.-1 p.m. and 2 -5 p.m., location to be announced later; November 3--Juneau, 9 a.m.--Noon and 1:30--5 p.m., to be announced later; November 4--Fairbanks, 9 a.m.-12 Noon and 1:30-3 p.m., North Star Borough Assembly Room, and, Barrow, 7-11 p.m., to be announced later; November 6--Nome, 1-5 p.m. ANB Hall; November 7--Bethel, 1-5 p.m. and 7-10 p.m., KVNA Building; November 8--Aniak, 1-5 p.m. and 7-10 p.m., Aniak Courthouse; November 9--Anchorage, 1-6 p.m., Anchorage Municipal Assembly Room.

All those interested in participating are welcome to attend. Written comments will also be accepted.
