## **for Alaskans**

Though Alaskans can forget about April 15 as a "day of reckoning" now that the individual income tax has been repealed, there is still a deadline that should not be forgotten. November 15 is the date Permanent Fund Dividend applications are due to be filed with the Department of Revenue.

Many Alaskans have put off filling out and mailing in their applications because the Alaska Supreme Court has not yet decided on the constitutionality of the dividend program. Only 94,000 of an expected 250,000 applications have been received by the Department of Revenue.

Though people may be confused about the status of the

Permanent Fund Dividend program, the deadline of November 15 will be in effect if the Supreme Court upholds the law as constitutional. For this reason Alaskans are urged to get their applications in as soon as possible.
