

# Dates changed for Festival

Dates for the annual Festival of Native Arts have been changed. This year's festival will be held Feb. 12-15 at the University of Alaska Fairbanks.

The annual festival, now in its twelfth year, has traditionally been held during the middle of March. Groups representing Alaska's Native peoples perform at the university during the festival.

The program has not been changed. An estimated 25 groups representing Alaska's diverse Native cultures will participate in the 1986 program. Groups are now being solicited for the program.

The Festival of Native Arts was organized by UAF Native students. The program is still organized and run by students. The date change is because the mid-March dates coincide with mid-term examinations at UAF. The student committee decided to change the dates to avoid the conflict of tests with the festival.
