Bear hunt permits available from ADF&G

Hunters are reminded that some spring bear hunts as well as a bull muskox hunts on Nunivak Island, are still on a permit drawing basis, and that application must be made by December 13.

One hundred twenty-eight (128) permits will be available for 26 bear hunt areas on Kodiak. Thirty-two (32) permits will be issued to nonresident grizzly bear hunters in northern game units, and 25 permits will be issued to resident hunters who wish to try for a bull muskox on Nunivak Island in mid-February.

None of these hunts were determined to the subsistence Tier II hunts by the Board of Game, so the winners will be drawn from a computer designed lottery program, authorities said. Permit applications are available at Department of Fish and Game offices and at some license vendors. Application fees are \$5 for the bear hunts and \$10 for the muskox hunt.
