

Olds decries VA cuts

Inadequate funding of the Veterans Administration means that 37,000 veterans are refused health care each month by that agency, says Glenn Olds, Democratic candidate for the

U.S. Senate.

In a recent speech Olds charged that current national administration proposals for the VA budget would mean a cut of \$408 million for 1987.

"What shall we make of those who think missiles are more important than men?" Olds asked.

He also charged that his opponent, Sen. Frank Murkowski, R-Alaska, has not adequately defended veterans benefits.
