

Natives sought for scholarship in-tour industry

Alaska Native students interested in travel management are invited to apply for the Walter Harper Scholarship, according to the Alaska Visitors Association.

The \$1,000 scholarship, donated by Princess Tours, is available through the Alaska Visitors Association Education Foundation. The award honors Harper, an Alaska Native who was the first person to reach the summit of Mount McKinley.

Applicants must be Alaska Natives enrolled in or intending to enroll in a four-year degree program in Travel Industry Management at an Alaska university. Students must have a minimum grade point average of 2.75 and submit an application form with two letters of reference.

The application deadline is April 13, 1990.
