

ALCOHOLISM REPORT IS RELEASED

Alaska ranks fifth in the nation on consumption of alcohol.

Statistics such as this are examined in a comprehensive report just published by Alaska's Office of Alcoholism, which was established in 1967.

Contents of the 100-page report include: death rates from alcoholism, treatment facilities available in the state, informational and educational programs, and an assessment of needs as well as goals and funding of the program.
