Road and Seward-Sterling Wye,
Safety Project, described herein

Commissioner's Office, Department
of Highways, Island Center
Building, Douglas, Alaska.

This project consists of grading,
drainage, and surface treatment of
0.38 miles of roadway. This project
is in two portions located at the
Seward-Sterling Wye and at the
Quartz Creek Road intersection
mileposts 37 and 45 respectively
along the Sterling Highway, north-
erly of Seward, Alaska.

Principal items of work consist
of the following: 29,100 cubic yards
of unclassified excavation; 2,700
tons of crushed aggregate base;
3,100 tons of subbase, grading B;
16 tons of cationic emulsified
asphalt; 148 tons of cover coat
material; 70 standard signs; and
miscellaneous items of work.

September 1, 1968.
