

Applicants sought for nursing grants

The Alaska Native Health Career Program is seeking applications for the Minority Nursing Scholarship.

Preference will be given to full-time minority nursing students who are Alaska Native, American Indian, Hispanic, black and Asian.

Junior and senior students enrolled in two- and four-year programs and who are in good standing will be given priority.

The Minority Nursing Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of need and as supplemental funding.

According to Katherine A. Johnson, R.N., program director, a total of \$1,000 in funds will be awarded this cycle.

The deadline for filing applications is Friday.

These funds were awarded to the Alaska Native Health Center Program by the Division of Nursing, Special Projects Grants of Rockville, Md., to assist minority and disadvantaged students to complete their nursing education.
