

Four-week Prospecting Course Offered at UA

A four-week Basic Prospecting course will be offered on the University of Alaska campus from March 9 through April 3, 1970. The course will be taught by Willow M. Burand.

This course is part of a statewide Mining Extension Program which includes Anchorage, Elmendorf Air Force Base, Ketchikan, Sitka, Homer, Kenai, Wrangell and Shaktoolik.

Mining Extension short courses have been offered since 1938 as a public service function of the University. Thousands of persons have attended the courses, many of whom have subsequently discovered and produced much valuable ore.

The class will meet in the evenings, Monday through Friday, between 7:00 and 10:00

p.m. in the Brooks Building on the University Campus.
