This project will consist of replacing 3 culverts with 2 single span bridges and one culvert on the Dalton Highway between the Yukon River and Prudhoe Bay.

Principal items of work consist of the following: All Required Construction Surveying by the Contractor; All Required Abutment Retaining Walls; 66 linear feet of 60 inch Pipe; 450 linear feet of Beam Type Guardrail, Type I Post; and one of the following options: Option I (Timber) All

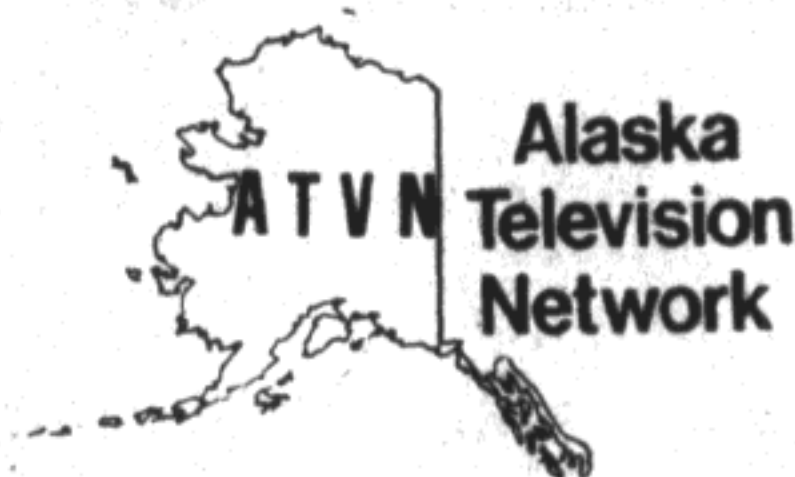
Required Treated Timber; 116 linear feet of Metal Bridge Railing; Option II (Concrete) 4 each of Precast Abutments; 8 each of Precast Concrete Structural Members (28'-10" Double Tee's); 116 linear feet of Metal Bridge Railing; Option III (Steel) All Required Structural Steel, Furnished, Fabricated and Erected; All Required Treated Timber; 116 linear feet of Metal Bridge Railing.
