Barrow Meet to Discuss Junk Drums

Senator Ted Stevens last week-end announced that the Navy has called a conference at Barrow to consider Stevens' program for the removal of junk oil drums and other scrap material from Naval Petroleum Reserve No. 4.

Stevens said that the Barrow interagency conference has been scheduled for November 17-18, 1970.

The senator stated that some 20 federal and state agencies will be represented by approximately 50 to 60 conferees to consider Stevens' proposal and other problems such as roads, potable water, gas distribution, sewage and refuse disposal and the formulation of long range

plans for the environmental protection of the tundra and the beaches.

Stevens said, "I am pleased that the Navy has called this

conference; the federal government must take the lead in clearing up its own mess and set an environmental example for private industry.
