

Generators For Rural Villages

JUNEAU—Governor Keith H. Miller announced that 52 diesel electric generator sets have been purchased to provide power at 26 rural schools.

The generators will be used to generate power in the schools in support of the hot lunch program authorized by 1970 legislation.

The 52 generator sets, in the 50 to 75 kilowatt range, were purchased at a cost of \$332,814. The award was made in total to Alaska Marine and Equipment of Anchorage.
