

Nome games held

Nome—More than 110 youngsters, 10-15 years old, representing 14 Northwestern Alaskan villages braved chilling winds and marginal field conditions, here Saturday in this community's first ever track meet, as 18 champions were selected for the ARCO Jesse Owens Games Fairbanks regionals slated later this month.

The Nome Preliminary running of the national track and field series, a novice program providing competition in running, jumping and throwing events, marked the first of three such rural Alaskan competitions.

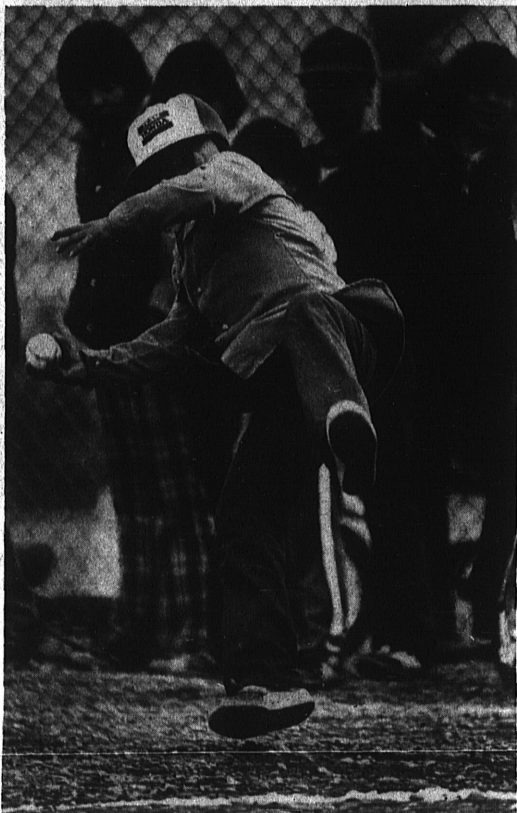
Barrow will host an eight village preliminary next Saturday while Kenai will conduct its area-wide meet on July 21.

Nome's winners will join Barrow's 18 champs in Fairbanks July 28 for regional competition while Kenai representatives will travel to Anchorage July 25 for its regional

meet.

Regional winners, 36 from each of the 14 participating cities around the country, will be hosted in Los Angeles August 18 for the national championships.

Representatives from Shishmaref, Wales, Gambell, Savoonga, White Mountain, Golovin, Ko-

vuk, Elim, Unalakleet, Stebbins, St. Michaels, Shaktoolik, Teller and Brevig Mission battled for ribbons in the 50, 100, 220 yard dashes, the long jump and the hard and softball throw. Boys and girls competed separately in age groups from 10-15 years of age.

Nome athletes garnered eight of the slots in the Fairbanks

meet while Shaktoolik, Unalakleet, St. Michaels provided two winners each. Golovin, Gambell, Koyuk, and Shishmaref had one winner each.
