NEED HELP TO BUY FOOD?

Food stamps may be a way of increasing your buying power so that you and your family can buy more food with less money. Food stamps can be used in most grocery stores. In certain rural areas they can also be used to buy subsistence hunting and fishing equipment.

You may be eligible for food stamps if you:

- 1) are a U.S. citizen or have permanent alien status.
- 2) are within certain income and resource limits, or have all household members receiving public assistance or supplemental security income.
- 3) complete a work registration form if requested.
