Gallagher Joins Bartlett Staff As Administrative Assistant

WASHINGTON — Hugh G. Gallagher, 35, will join the staff of Senator E. L. Bartlett May 6 as administrative

assistant, the senator announced this week.

Gallagher takes over the position held by Miss Mary Lee Council since 1945 when Bartlett came to Washington as Territorial Delegate. Miss Council retired from the post last July 1.

Gallagher served as a legislative assistant to Bartlett between January 1963 and December 1966.

After leaving Bartlett's office, Gallagher was awarded a Congressional Staff Fellowship by the American Political Science Association to write a book on the Senate

and foreign policy. It is scheduled to be published later this year by Dell Press.

Last July Gallagher went to work for the Bureau of the Budget which coordinates all facets of the administration's activities. He was a legislative analyst on trade matters.

Gallagher is a graduate of Claremont Men's College in Pomona, Calif. As a Marshall Scholar in 1959 Gallagher earned a master's degree in political science and economics at Oxford University in England.

Gallagher has been a frequent visitor to Alaska both on pleasure trips and as a representative of Senator Bartlett.
